We loved you so dearly in your lifetime, and even in death we will do the same. Your sudden demise has totally shattered and broken our hearts.

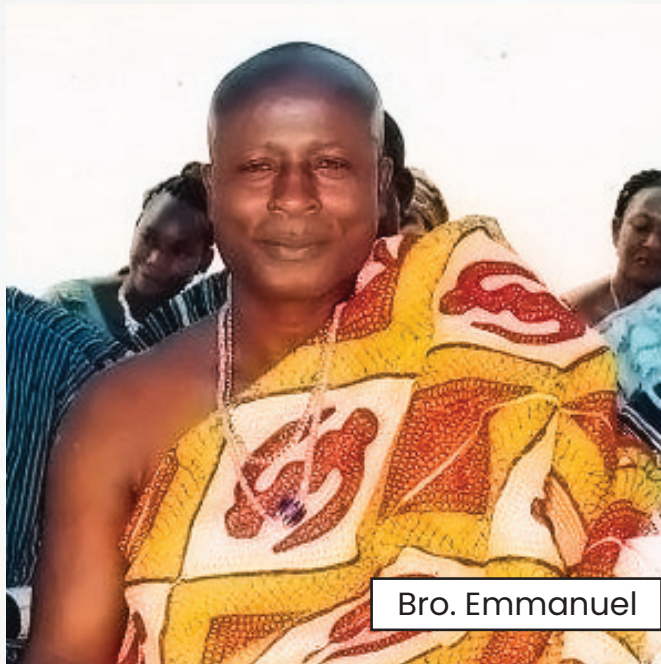
You did not go alone; part of us went with you. Brother, your death is not an end, because your virtues will continue to vibrate in us, our children and generations to come.

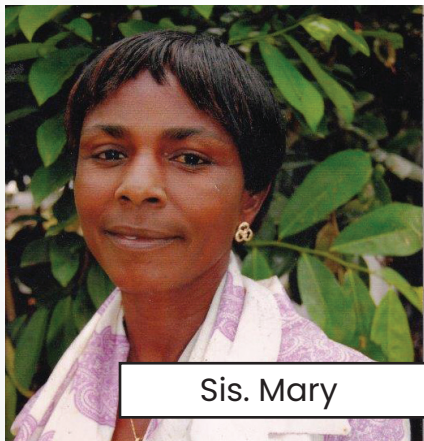

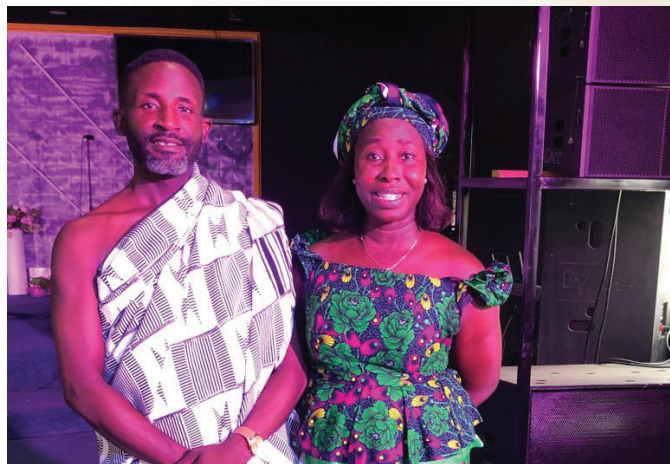
Who am I going to sing with now that you are no longer here? We always sang together to Jesus, filling our home with the sweet, angelic sound of your voice.

You exceeded every expectation of what a good and responsible father could ever be for his children. We couldn't have asked for a better father from God than you.

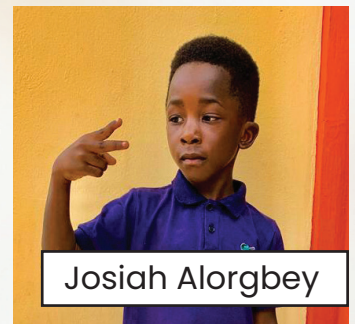

Who will buy our elder sister the car on her 18th birthday as you promised?

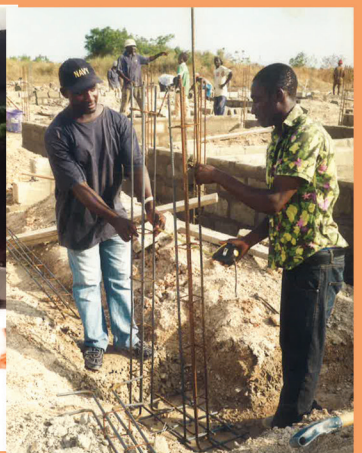
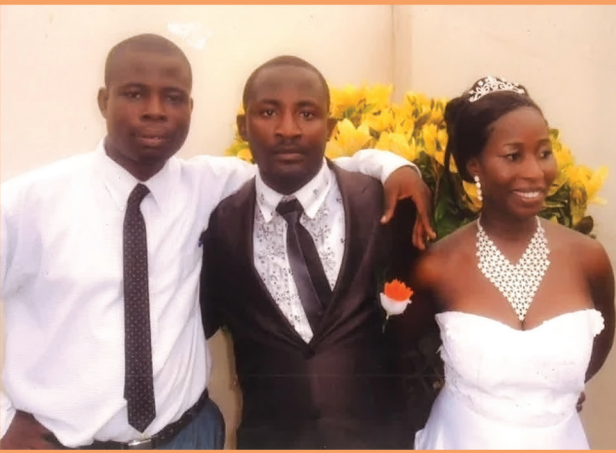

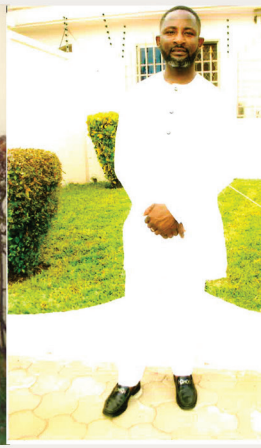
